**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to the order dated 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2018, Report has been submitted by the District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas as well as the Superintendents of Police of said District.
2. As per the Report, the brickfields in question were indeed found to be in operation for a certain period of time illegally without having obtained the requisites Consents to Operate. Accordingly, as directed, environmental compensation of Rs. 3.5 Lakh each had been determined against them and directed to pay to the West Bengal Pollution Control Board.
3. The Reports are directed to be taken on record.
4. Mr. Mohinoor Rahaman, Advocate, appearing for the brickfields in question acknowledges the fact of its illegal operation and fairly submits that the Environmental Compensation assessed by the District Magistrate has since been deposited with the West Bengal

Pollution Control Board in support of which receipts granted by the State Pollution Control Board have been produced by him.

5. In view of these facts, nothing remains to be determined by us in the present case.

6. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of with no order as to costs.
