Proceedings have been initiated in this matter on receipt of a letter alleging that pollution is being caused by burning of rubber tyres in a factory, for production of fuel oil, adjacent to the habitation of village Gesupur, Tehsil Mawana-via-Kithor District Meerut, Uttar Pradesh. It is being done by one Ashok Kumar son of Satyapal Singh, who has set up the factory, adjacent to the village habitation.</p> <p>2. Having regard to the seriousness of the allegation made, since the alleged activity is clearly in violation of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, apart from other laws for which action is required to be taken by Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board, we direct the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board to examine the facts and take appropriate action in accordance with law.</p> <p>3.
