ORDER

1. A report was sought from South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SDMC) and the SDM, Mayapuri with reference to the allegation of failure to manage waste bin (*Dhalao*) at Mayapuri Industrial Area Phase-II, New Delhi.

2. Accordingly, the SDMC has filed an action taken report dated 11.01.2020 as follows:

"The concerned SS as well as the Concessionaire vide letter No. ECOGREEN SDMC/2019-20/9387 dated 14.01.2020 reported that:

(1) Dhalao No. 137 Mayapuri Ph-II, Ward No. 010-S, is a prominent Dhalao where huge quantity of garbage, approximately 6-7 MT per day has been collected dumped.

(2) In case of closing of this Dhalao sanitation condition of the area will be badly affected.

(3) *There is no other Dhalao in nearby vicinity at which the garbage dumped at this Dhalao can be diverted.*

(4) *To provide good sanitation condition in the area as per Rules and Regulation this Dhalao is essentially required to be maintained.*

*In view of above, as per primary prayer of the applicant the shifting/closing of Dhalao bearing No. 137 in Ward No. 010-S, Mayapuri Ph-II, West Zone is not seems feasible. However, as per alternative prayer of the applicant, **the SDMC shall ensure that the Dhalao be maintained on regular basis and the concessionaire, M/s EESL provide appropriate machinery equipments, sufficient staff at this site to remove the MSW collected/dumped frequently as well as keep the Dhalao neat & clean and maintain the hygienic condition at the site as per terms& condition of the agreement***

3. In view of the above, let the SDMC take appropriate steps to maintain the waste centre (*Dhalao*) scientifically as per statutory rules, free of vector and bad odour so as to manage the waste

The application is disposed of.
