Delay condoned.

We have heard learned counsel appearing for the parties and perused the record.

We find from the order dated 27.07.2018 passed by the National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi (at page 66 Annexure P-6 in the appeal paper-book) vide paragraph nos.10 and 11 that the Tribunal permitted diesel buses of more than 10 years old to ply for the unexpired period of three years on the condition that they will not

enter into NCT Delhi.

Accordingly, we permit the appellants to ply diesel buses for the unexpired period of three years from today on the condition that they will not enter into NCT Delhi.

However, Ms. Chinmayee Chandra, learned counsel appearing for the respondent - Ministry of Road, Transport and Highways, prays for some time to make a statement about the availability of environmental friendly modes of transport.

Prayer is allowed.
