ORDER

This application has been filed by the petitioner seeking following reliefs:-

- “1] To direct the Respondents that eatable waste should be thrown separately and within the paper bags or in cloth bags, so that the same can be reused for the survival and basic requirement of such creatures;
- 2] To direct the Respondents to replace the heightened dustbins from the dustbins with smaller height, so that automatic disposal and recycle of waste can take place. Moreover, utilization of waste and garbage for the welfare of the homeless people, whose livelihood is dependent upon the collection of waste will also become effective if the height of the dustbins are reduced.
- 3] That, in the alternative, keep a small dustbin nearby the heightened dustbin, so that the homeless people and

cattle/creatures can reach the said dustbins for their livelihood;

4] To direct the Respondents to recycle the garbage into a bio-energy plant;

5] To direct the Respondents to maintain the greenery and to protect the environment.”

After having considered the prayer made by the applicant and the grievance raised by him, we are of the view that this is a fit case for referring to the Special Committee constituted by NGT under its order dated 30.08.2019 in original application no. 606/2018.

Accordingly, the applicant is directed to approach the Committee headed by Hon'ble Justice Trivedi and make his presentation before it for seeking redressal of the grievances.

Accordingly, the original application (75/2017) is disposed of, with no order as to cost.
