ORDER

1. M.A. No. 83/2018 for urgent hearing is allowed.
2. M.A. No. 91/2018 for taking the additional document on record is allowed.
3. Aggrieved by the order dated 15.02.2016 in case no. (1) 211/Khanij/2016; (2) 212/Khanij/2016; and, (3) 213/Khanij/2016 granting permission to the Respondent No. 4 to carry mining of Granite over Khasra No. 593 over an area total admeasuring 11.75 hectare, this application has been filed for the relief and direction as follows:

(i) *“Call for entire records pertaining to permissions granted in favour of Respondent No. 4.*

- (ii) *Restrain the Respondent No. 4 from carrying Mining with immediate effect as an interim and final relief.*
- (iii) *Quash the order dated 15.02.2016 granting prospecting license of Mining Granite issued in favour of Respondent No. 4 on Khasra No. 593, Gram- Luv Kush Nagar, Chattarpur.*
- (iv) *To direct the State Government and other respondents to issue closure directions to Respondent No. 4 and quantify the damage caused by Respondent No. 5, if any.*
- (v) *To direct the Respondent No. 4 to take steps for restitution of the environment and also to pay damages and compensation to the Petitioner/victims of the pollution and other for the environmental damage caused by it over the years under Section 15 of the Act.”*

4. As per annexure 1 Column 2 the order was issued on 15.02.2016 for two years, meaning thereby the order is not in operation at present.

5. We feel it appropriate to constitute a Joint Committee consisting:

(i) Collector, Chattarpur, District Chhatarpur, M.P. or his representative

(ii) Representative of Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board and

(iii) The Mining Officer, Chhatarpur, M.P.

6. And the Committee is directed to submit a factual and action taken report with reference to the fact narrated in the application. The PCB will be the nodal agency for coordination and logistic support.

7. Let a report in the matter be filed by the Committee by e-mail at judicial-ngt@gov.in preferably in the form of

searchable PDF/ OCR Support PDF and not in the form of Image PDF. Report be filed within four weeks.
