UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following O R D E R

Re-list in May 2023.

In the meanwhile, respondent No. 1 – Maharashtra Maritime Board will file an affidavit within six weeks, indicating the number of jetties under construction or to be constructed under the project being implemented, impact on the Mangroves in each case, with size/area of the Mangroves and distance of the jetty from the Mangrove. Site plan(s) indicating location of the jetty and Mangroves around the said area would be enclosed. Satellite images for each jetty and the area around, would be also filed for proper appreciation and expeditious disposal.

It is pointed out that the jetty at Narangi has been constructed, but in view of the stay order passed by this Court, construction of the Kharwadeshwari jetty has been stalled. Consequently, the jetty at Narangi cannot be utilised. In view of the urgency, need and benefits explained, leaving the question of law open for the time being, we permit the respondent(s) to construct the jetty at Kharwadeshwari.
