- (a) whether the COVID-19 vaccination drive for children and others has been put on hold in the country by the Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons for non availability of vaccine slots in the country including Delhi & NCR's vaccination centres; and
- (c) the total number of COVID-19 doses of vaccination administered to children above the age of 12 years to prevent the spread of COVID-19 among children in the country?

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. S.P. SINGH BAGHEL)

(a) to (c): The National COVID-19 Vaccination Programme covers all children and others above the age of 12 years of age. All States/UTs were advised by the Ministry to continue the vaccination of eligible beneficiaries and the programme is ongoing in States/UTs that procured vaccine doses.

As on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2023, a total of 10.34 crore beneficiaries have received 1<sup>st</sup> dose and 8.63 crore beneficiaries have received 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of Covid-19 vaccine in 12-18 years age group in the country.

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
