ORDER

1. Grievance in this application is against de-sealing of scrapping units operating illegally in Mayapuri Industrial Area in Delhi, which were earlier sealed in pursuance of orders of this Tribunal. The applicant points out that the Tribunal issued directions in O.A. 807/2018, *News item published in "The Times of India" Authored by Paras Singh titled "Ignoring NGT orders, Mayapuri 'graveyard' spews toxic fumes"* for remedial action against illegal operation of vehicle scrapping units in Mayapuri which led to sealing of certain units. The said units have been later de-sealed. The applicant has also found other sites where illegal

scrapping units are still functioning. The geo tag locations of the same are given in the application as follows:
