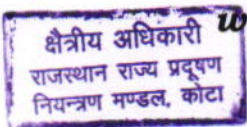
COMPLIANCE REPORT OF THIS HON'BLE TRIBUNAL
ORDER DATED 20.08.2019, ON BEHALF OF
RAJASTHAN STATE POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD.

I, Vijay Sharma S/o Lt. Shri Krishan Kumar Sharma aged about 47 years, at present working as Regional Officer, Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board, Kota (Raj.) do, hereby submits the compliance report as follows:-

- 1) That the Hon'ble Tribunal by order dated 20.08.2019 directed as follows:-

“Grievance in this letter, which has been treated as an application, is against illegal mining through crusher machine in Village Chenupuria, Tehsil Chipabadod, District Barah, Rajasthan damaging the forest area.

Let the District Magistrate, Barah and the State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) jointly look into the matter, take appropriate action in accordance with law and furnish a factual and action taken report within one month by e-mail at judicial-ngt@gov.in. The nodal agency will be the SPCB for coordination and compliance”




2) That in compliance of this Hon'ble Tribunal order inspection of M/s Jyoti Kiran Stone Crusher, at Khasra no. 203/137, Village Faliya, Tehsil Chhipa Barod, District Baran was conducted on 20.12.2019 jointly by a team of officials from District Administration, Mining Department, Forest Department, Agriculture Department and Health Department. During the course of inspection the stone crusher was non-operative for maintenance of machinery. The team had also inspected the said mining pit at village Chainpuriya Khasra no. 96/26. During the course of inspection it was observed that pit of surface area about 21 meters x 55 meters is there within the Khasra no. 96/26. The pit was filled with rain water. As reported by the Asst. Mining Engineer, the Department of Mines & Geology has not issued any permission/permit for mining on the said land. It has also been reported that looking to the site conditions, mining in the pit might have been done prior to the last rainy season (approx. 6 month ago) and there are no marks/sign of recent mining activities in the area. The photo copy of the joint inspection reports are annexed herewith and marked as **Annexure-1 (Collectively)**.

As per the physical observation of pollution control measures at the stone crusher, the RSPCB had issued show cause notice on 19/02/2020 for intended revocation of consent to operate and intended directions under section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981. The RSPCB has given opportunity of being heard (OBH) to the

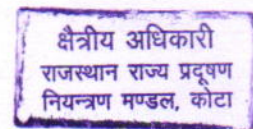
project proponent to submit reply and requisite details/documents, if he desires so, in person or through his representative on 02.03.2020 at 3.00 PM. The photo copy of the show cause notice dated 19.02.2020 is annexed herewith and marked as **Annexure-2**.

- 3) That the OBH was conducted on 02.03.2020 and attended by the Director of the unit. During OBH, it was decided that the project proponent shall complete the remaining work of construction of boundary wall by 30.04.2020 and shall also submit bank guarantee of Rs. 1 Lakh as a surety in this regard. Also, Environment Compensation shall be imposed for the past violation as per guidelines of the State Board.
- 4) That in the light of submissions made herein above, it is requested that the compliance report may kindly be taken on record.


