Let the Madhya Pradesh State Pollution Control Board (MPSPCB) look into the matter, take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Needless to say that order of National Green Tribunal is binding as a decree of Court and non-compliance is actionable by way of

punitive action including prosecution, in terms of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010.
