The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant has submitted that the appellant, which is a wholly-owned State government undertaking, has taken necessary steps for installing the anti-pollution devices. Hence, it has been submitted that the quantum of penalty of Rs 25 lakhs should be suitably reduced.

Issue notice, condition on the appellant depositing an amount of Rs 10 lakhs in compliance with the impugned order of the National Green Tribunal before the District Legal Services Authority, as directed.

The amount shall be deposited within a period of four weeks from today, upon which notice shall be issued, subject to the filing of proof of deposit. The notice will be returnable in six weeks.
