**ORDER**

1. The issue raised in this application is unscientific and unregulated dumping of municipal solid waste and construction & demolition waste on public land in Khasra Nos. 127, 157 and 164 by Respondent No. 3, Nagar Parishad of Palwal in open area in Village Hodal Garhi Patti, District Palwal, Haryana.

2. The continuous and unscientific dumping of the Municipal Solid Waste & Construction & demolition waste is giving rise to the catastrophic consequences like air pollution, water pollution, land pollution, soil pollution and much more in the nearby areas. The people residing in the nearby villages are getting adapted to the harmful health hazards which are arising due to the dumping and disposing off the Waste in the open area. The dumping zone has caused a very foul and obnoxious smell which is making the lives of the villagers residing in the adjoining villages totally miserable. Moreover, the people who are residing in the nearby villages are

suffering from severe health hazards which are giving rise to many deadly diseases like in the Human Respiratory System and even cancer.

3. The Tribunal has earlier dealt issues of solid waste and C&D waste management at Village Garhi Patti, Hodal and Village Meghpur, District Hodal vide order dated 16.07.2021 in OA No. 291/2020, *Jaipal Singh & Ors. vs. State of Haryana & Ors.* and order dated 01.11.2022 OA No. 391/2019, *SND Public School, Palwal vs. State of Haryana & Ors.* respectively inter-alia directing to take remedial measures.

4. A substantial issue of environment has been raised.

5. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks. Respondents are directed to submit their reply within four weeks through E-filing portal, preferably in the form of searchable PDF/ OCR Support PDF and not in the form of Image PDF.

6. Applicant is directed to take necessary steps for service to the respondents by both ways and also on available email.

7. We deem it just and proper to call a report on the matter in issue in present Original Application, from a Joint Committee consisting of:-

- i. District Magistrate, Palwal
- ii. Municipal Commissioner, Nagar Parishad, Palwal
- iii. One representative from Haryana State Pollution Control Board

8. The Committee is directed to visit the place and submit the factual and action taken report within four weeks giving details on discharge of waste at such non-notified sites and punitive actions against violators and further ensuring that waste generated in the jurisdiction of Nagar Parishad

Palwal is processed at identified site in accordance with the rules. The State PCB will be the nodal agency for coordination and logistic support.

9. The report in the matter be filed by the Committee by e-mail at [judicial-ngt@gov.in](mailto:judicial-ngt@gov.in) preferably in the form of searchable PDF/OCR Support PDF and not in the form of Image PDF.

10. Applicant is directed to supply the copy of the application and relevant documents to the Committee and Respondent(s) within a week and after compliance of service, the applicant has to submit an affidavit that the notice and copy of the application have been served upon the Committee and respondent(s).

List the matter on 29.08.2023.

A copy of this order be forwarded to District Magistrate, Palwal, Municipal Commissioner, Nagar Parishad, Palwal and Haryana State PCB by e-mail for compliance.
