ORDER

1. This Execution Application relates to compliance of direction of this Tribunal requiring the Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh to deploy machines and manpower for segregation of waste at source and at the site of the project proponent.
2. The order was passed in proceedings for compliance of Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016. The Tribunal had also constituted an oversight Committee for the purpose of compliance of directions of this Tribunal. Even though the mandate of the Committee may have come to an end, to put at rest the controversy now raised, we consider it appropriate to require the Committee to furnish a factual report in the matter. The composition of the Committee is as follows:

1. Member Secretary, Chandigarh Pollution Control Committee.

2. Representative of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change from its Regional Office at Chandigarh.
 3. A Professor from Punjab Engineering College from the Environment field, nominated by the Director of that institute.
 4. Representative of Central Pollution Control Board from its Regional Office, Chandigarh.
3. The nodal agency for compliance and controversy will be the representative of the CPCB. The report may be furnished within one month by email at judicial-ngt@gov.in.
 4. A copy of the order be sent to the Member Secretary, Chandigarh Pollution Control Committee, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Regional Office at Chandigarh, Punjab Engineering College and the Central Pollution Control Board by email.
 5. The applicant may furnish a separate set of papers each to the Member Secretary, Chandigarh Pollution Control Committee, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Regional Office at Chandigarh, Punjab Engineering College and the Central Pollution Control Board and file an affidavit of service within one week.
