O R D E R

1. In sum and substance, the stand taken on behalf of the respondents is that khasra nos.490, 522, 552, and 676 as well as

the land comprising other water bodies have not been allotted to any-one. Some of these khasra numbers were earlier allotted but the allottees have surrendered the same.

- 2. We have seen the photographs placed on record, which suggest that the water bodies are presently lying as barren land and are required to be restored along with the catchment area.
- 3. Learned senior counsel for the Greater Noida and learned Senior AAG for the State of Uttar Pradesh assures to submit the restoration plan within four weeks.
- 4. The further affidavits be filed by the officers, who are presently posted.
- 5. Post the matter on 09.10.2023.
