- (c) the number of towns and cities in the country, particularly in Tamil Nadu that would be benefitted under the scheme; and**
- (d) the details of direct job opportunities that the projects are expected to create over the years?**

**(a) to (d): 'PM-eBusSewa Scheme' has been launched recently by the**

**Government of India under which ‘Green Urban Mobility Initiatives’ (GUMI) provides for proposals of urban mobility infrastructure and services like bus priority infrastructure, multimodal interchange facilities, Intelligent Transit Management System, National Common Mobility Card (NCMC)-based Automated Fare Collection System and charging infrastructure including projects demonstrating reduction in Green House Gas (GHG) emissions. 181 Indian cities with 3 lakh and above population size, as per census 2011, including 12 cities of Tamil Nadu, are eligible to participate in this segment of the Scheme. Selection of projects under GUMI segment will be done as per the challenge method prescribed in the Scheme guidelines. The direct job opportunities are linked to the type of projects to be implemented by the concerned cities.**
