Report of the Registry dated 26th August, 2017 points out that the structure is touching the flood plain line and the pillar abutting the project boundary is Pillar No. RU-33.

The Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Association submits that the boundary wall abutting the said pillar has been demolished.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the State of Uttar Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board submit that they have no clear instructions in regard to the demolition of the said structure. The State of Uttar Pradesh and UPPPCB to confirm whether the wall has been demolished.
