<b>Order no. 7 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2015</b>	<p>Learned Counsel for RIICO prays for time though, it has been brought to our notice that the fly-ash generated by the Thermal Power Stations in Rajasthan is being utilised to the extent of about 90%, out of which majority of it is being utilised in the Cement Industry and partially in road construction.</p> <p>Learned Counsel for Respondents, on being apprised by the Counsel for the Applicant submits that the areas where silos are located for filling up the tankers and transportation of the fly-ash are a source of severe air pollution and are highly polluted. Dr. M.S.Kachhawa, Learned Counsel for the Respondents No. 14, 15 &amp; 16 submitted that they would take effective steps by drawing up a programme for improving the conditions including concretisation of the area for loading of trucks as well as for parking of the trucks so as to check air pollution. The District Administration particularly, the Police shall ensure that the trucks are not parked on the highway. At the same time the local authorities including the Urban Improvement Trust shall draw up a scheme for providing better facilities to the transporters and their drivers / attendants including facilities for refreshments and toilets, etc.</p> <p>The Respondents shall submit their response in this behalf with the plan drawn up and financial allocation made for the same by the next</p>

date.

Shri Om S.Shrivastav appearing for the State of Rajasthan shall provide information with regard to implementation of the provisions contained in the MoEF notification of 2009 (Annexure A/1) whereby States have been directed to ensure compulsory utilisation and use of cement bricks in place of clay bricks in the Government works and buildings.
