"(1A) Every construction agency engaged in the construction of buildings within a radius of hundred kilometers from a coal or lignite based thermal power plant shall use only fly ash based products for constructions, such as: cement or concrete, fly ash bricks or blocks or tiles or clay fly ash bricks, blocks or tiles or cement fly ash bricks or bricks or blocks or similar products or a combination or aggregate of them in every construction project.

(1B) The provisions of sub-paragraphs (1A) shall be applicable to all construction agencies of Central or State or Local Government and private or public sector and it shall be the responsibility of the agencies either undertaking construction or approving the design or both to ensure compliance of the provisions of sub-paragraphs (IA) and to submit annual returns to the concerned State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control committee, as applicable".

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Applic<mark>ant in Original Applic</mark>ation No. 102 of <mark>20</mark>14 submits that there is no escape from this obligation and every construction agency engaged in the construction of buildings be those of the State Government/Local Government/Private Public Sector situate within the radius of 100 kms from coal and lignite based thermal power plants has to use only fly ash based products for construction as mandated and, therefore, it is necessary to hold the concerned authorities committing breach of this obligation liable for penal consequences.

It is brought to our notice at this stage that for enforcement and implementation of the provision of this Notification, there is inbuilt mechanism provided by amended Notification dated 03-11-2009.

(6) A monitoring committee shall be constituted by the Central Government with Members from Ministry of Coal, Ministry of Mines, Ministry of Power, Central Pollution control Board, Central Electricity Authority, Head Fly Ash Unit of Department of Science and Technology and Building Material Technology Promotion Council to monitor the implementation of the provisions of the notification and submit its recommendations or observations at least once in every six months to the Secretary, Ministry of Environment and Forests. Concerned Advisor Joint Secretary in the Ministry Environment and Forest will be convener of this committee.

(7)For the purpose of monitoring the implementation of the provisions this notification the State Governments or Union territory Government shall constitute Monitoring Committee within three months from the date of issue of this notification under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Department of with representatives Department of Power, Department of Mining, Road and Building Construction Department and State Pollution Control Board and this Committee would deal with any unresolved issue by Dispute Settlement Committee as prescribed in sub-paragraph (4) of paragraph 1, in addition to monitoring and facilitating implementation of this notification at the respective State Government or Union territory level and this Committee would also be empowered to suitably modify (waive or relax) the stipulation under sub-paragraph (1) in case of non-availability of fly ash in sufficient quantities from thermal power plant as certified by the said power plants and the Committee will meet at least once in every quarter".

We, therefore, direct the concerned authorities, the Respondents, MoEF and the State Governments and Union Territories to place before us the facts concerning the constitution of the Monitoring Committees on the next date of hearing and the action taken by such Monitoring Committees if constituted already; and if such Monitoring Committee has not been constituted as mandated the State Governments and/or Union Territories shall constitute such Monitoring Committee within four (4) weeks from today.
