		Learned counsel appearing for the East Delhi
		Municipal Corporation submits that he needs to take
		instructions. However, he is not in a position to deny that
		the garbage is lying on the roads of the Delhi. It is pointed
		out that garbage have been dumped around residential

houses causing serious threat to environment and public health. Consequently, we direct the matter to be reopened.

Notice be issued to the all the Municipal Corporations of Delhi as well as NCT of Delhi.

Notice returnable on 30th October, 2015.

In the meanwhile, we direct that all the Corporations shall ensure that dumped garbage within the area of their jurisdiction should be removed and take it to the appropriate sites and/or municipal solid waste plant in Delhi.

We direct NCT of Delhi to provide due co-operation to all the Corporations to ensure compliance of this order.

Let the Chief Secretary, NCT of Delhi and the all the Commissioners of the respective Corporations be informed of this order by the Registry by fax and telephonically as

well.
