		Having noticed failure of the stone crusher units in
		taking adequate pollution control measures as per the
		provision of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act,
		1981 and the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution)
		Act, 1974, we had directed closure of the stone crushing
		activities. We also directed the closure of the mining
		activities which have been carried out on the Gaucher
		land without obtaining Environmental Clearance/s.

However, the order of the Hon'ble High Court was not brought to our notice then.

We therefore allow mining activity to be carried out strictly as per the order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 09th April, 2015. As regards the stone crushers, we direct the State Pollution Control Board to carry out the inspection of the stone crushing units and report to us about the compliances, if any, made by them as regards taking of the pollution control measures and such other measures to check the pollution. We, therefore, do not wish to pass any direction as regard the running of the stone crushing units till the report of the compliance is placed before us.
