Two weeks time is granted for filing the replies with advance copies to the Applicant who may file Rejoinder(s) thereto, if any, within one week thereafter.</p> <p>This application raises a issue of dumping hazardous wastes containing heavy metals in the green belt. The Learned Counsel appearing for Respondent No. 2 - Delhi Pollution Control Committee submits that samples have been collected from the place which is allegedly used for dumping of hazardous wastes and analysis of samples will bring out the merit of the present case. He submits that samples were sent to Central Pollution Control Board for analysis and the results are awaited.</p>

The Learned Counsel appearing on behalf the Applicant submits that samples were collected on 07<sup>th</sup> March, 2016. The Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of Central Pollution Control Board submits that he will have to take instructions in this regard to make a statement as to when the analysis would be over. However, from the fact that the samples were collected on 07<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 and sent to the Central Pollution Control Board, we believe and hope that analysis of the samples collected would be completed within one week. Let the analysis of samples be completed and the result be placed before the Tribunal by the next date of hearing.
