Orders of the Tribunal

The joint inspection report has been filed. The joint inspection report shows that the Hotel is having 18 rooms and per day production of sewage would be 4 KLD. The report shows that there is only one septic tank of 5 M^{3.} If that be so the capacity of the septic tank would not be sufficient even for two days. The report also shows that the overflow of the septic tanks is sealed. As there is no sufficient capacity of septic tank. It is also seen that there is no arrangement for over flow of the septic tanks and hence there is possibility for by-pass of the sewage to the nearby areas, specially - where there is no sewer line connection in that area. The Unit cannot be permitted to operate as sought for when there is no sewer line in that area. The Applicant is at liberty to provide sufficient capacity of septic tank and thereafter apply for fresh consent. The Applicant is to be permitted to carry out expansion of the septic tanks, if applied, by the Pollution Control Board.

Original Application No. 49 of 2016 stands disposed of without any order as to costs.
