Item No. 10 January 10, 2013	<p>Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties at some length, we direct the Member Secretary, Pollution Control Board, Jharkhand to depute a Scientist / an Environment Engineer to visit the premises in question and report as to whether Respondent No.4 is discharging the dolachar at the land in dispute either in the past or presently. Let the report to this effect be submitted within two weeks from today.</p> <p>Further, he shall communicate this order to the Member Secretary of the Pollution Control Board, Jharkhand and the report shall positively reach to the Tribunal before the next date of hearing which is 12th February, 2013.</p> <p>The Engineer shall also specify if there is any other industry around the specified land which is producing and/or discharging as its waste dolachar.
