Item no. 1 9th July, 2014	<p>Heard. Perused.</p> <p>These petitions were initiated before the Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh for directions to restrain the illegal mining in Protected Area of forest in District Satna and for initiation of action against the persons concerned. The report prepared by the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests dated 04.10.2011, forms the basis of the petitions. This report brings forth instances of illegal mining going on in the Forest area.</p> <p>We have, therefore, directed the State of Madhya Pradesh to file a detailed Action Taken Report as to whether the mining activity in the Forest area came to an end and whether any action has been taken against the culprits and the officials involved therein vide direction dated 11.03.2014. On 07.05.2014, the State sought time to respond to the directions with a fresh Action Taken Report.</p> <p>Today, the Learned Counsel for the State submits that two weeks' time is needed to bring forth all the facts as of today. Time is</p>

granted. However, the failure to respond on the next date would call for the presence of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests before us to present the facts necessary for disposal of these petitions.
