Item no. 4 24 th January, 2014	<p>Shri Ayush Dev Bajpai, Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of Shri Sachin K. Verma, Learned Counsel for the Respondent 2 submits that on 04.01.2014 a meeting was convened by the District Collector, Gwalior. He also read out the Minutes of the Meeting. However we find that specific information with regard to the points that have been raised in various hearings before us have not been brought out. Shri Ayush Dev Bajpai, Learned Counsel submits that the District Collector, Gwalior has directed the concerned agencies to prepare a plan and estimates to carry out the work as directed in our orders and same shall be submitted before the Tribunal.</p> <p>The meeting was convened by the District Collector, Gwalior on 04.01.2014 and already 20 days have elapsed. We are not satisfied with the aforesaid response. Accordingly we direct that the District Collector, Gwalior shall personally attend the hearing on 29.01.2014 and shall place before us for our perusal the concrete plan prepared by the Public Works Department and other concerned agencies with estimates so that the Associations of the stone crushing units may be apprised regarding their share / contribution for construction of 'Pakka' Road etc. from the sites of</p>

the mines and crushing units up to the national highway to reduce the pollution in the area as it was generally felt that the plying of the vehicles with heavy load from the mining and crushing units on 'Kachha' tracks was resulting in heavy air pollution and thereby adversely affecting the health of the residents in the nearby areas. Shri Bajpai, Learned Counsel shall convey our above order to the District Collector, Gwalior and we expect that the District Collector, Gwalior shall remain present as directed with the required information.

As per our earlier orders, the Member Secretary, MPPCB has carried out the inspection and submitted the report on 22.01.2014. Same be taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to the Learned Counsel for the Applicant.
