Verma, Learned Counsel appearing for the State of M.P. seeks further time to submit the compliance report and information regarding implementation of Rule 115 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 pertaining to the requirement of PUC certificate for the motor vehicles in the State.</p> <p>It was brought to our notice that in the National Capital Region/State of Delhi orders have been issued making it mandatory for all the petrol pumps to ensure that fuel (petrol & diesel) shall be supplied to only those vehicles which are having valid PUC.
