Corporation in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- to the satisfaction of the arresting Officer, in exercise of our powers and in terms of the provision of Section 19 (4) (a) of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010 read with Order XVI Rule 10(3) and Section 151 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908. The bailable warrant shall be executed by the SHO of the concerned area for their production. They shall be present with complete records. Keeping in view the massive collection of and waste the same continuing indiscriminately, even now, without any effective measures including segregation and proper dumping, we direct and prohibit the Municipal Corporation and the State Government from throwing any waste, municipal solid waste or any kind of waste at the site in question that is Achan at Srinagar.
