	Item No. 11 May 10, 2016 A	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>M.A. No. 417 of 2016</u></p> <p>It is stated by the Learned counsel appearing for the Applicant that the work for construction and operationalisation of the municipal solid waste plant at Shimla has already been awarded. The Power Purchase Agreement which is one of the ingredients would be signed by Monday i.e. 16th May, 2016 and within five months the said plant will become operative. The Project Proponent is also present before the Tribunal.</p> <p>Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstance and the fact that there is no plant presently operating in the State of Himachal Pradesh, including its capital at Shimla, it is necessary that the municipal solid waste instead of being dumped in the Hilly Valley should taken to Chandigarh site and provided to the plant. In the connected matter it has already been brought to the notice of the Tribunal that the plant at Chandigarh has still the capacity to receive more municipal solid waste and treat the same for utilization for power generation.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">In the facts and circumstances, we pass a direction</p>

that the Municipal Solid Waste Green Tech Processing plant at Chandigarh would accept the municipal solid waste of Shimla and the State of Himachal Pradesh would pay toping fee to that plant.

Accordingly, M.A. No. 417 of 2016 stands disposed of without any order as to costs.
