However, he has submitted that debris of the structure and restitution of the area to its original form needs to be done.</p> <p>The Officer of the Municipal Corporation, present before us, undertakes to do the needful including removal of debris and restitution of the area in question within a period of two weeks from today.</p> <p>In view of the fact that substantial compliance has been done by the SDMC and the fact that the Officer present before us shall immediately do the work of restitution of the area to its original form, we deem it just and proper to dispose of this Execution Application.</p>
