Item No. 2 November 11, 2013	<p>The Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) has filed its report, as earlier directed by this Tribunal. On reading of this report it shows that the road side noise level in the area is beyond the permissible limit. However, the report does not contain the status about the noise level near the residential colony. Accordingly, we direct the DPCC to file further report regarding the noise level which is in existence in the locality concerned.</p> <p>We also direct, in the meantime, the Traffic Police of Delhi to study and find out about the possibility of regulating the heavy vehicles movement from this particular area through some other area.
