<b>Date and Remarks</b>	<b>Orders of the Tribunal</b>
<b>Item No. 16 December 23, 2015 A</b>	<b><u>M.A. No. 1327 of 2015</u></b>  We dispose of this Application with the following directions:-  1. The industry would be permitted to operate only for a period of one month at the first instance from today.  2. During this month a surprise joint inspection would be conducted by the joint inspection team.  3. They shall file a complete and comprehensive, analysis report on air and water quality.  4. The Committee shall specifically state as to the steps which have been taken by the industry after orders of the Board for taking remedial or

corrective measures and what is their effect. It shall also be stated what was extent of pollution resulting from the industry prior to installation of anti pollution devices.

We are informed that the industry also does not have the permission of the CGWA. Learned counsel appearing for the Authority submit that they are going to expedite the consideration of Application and would pass appropriate orders.

If the joint inspection report is in favour of the Applicant. The Applicant would be at liberty to move the Tribunal for continuation of its operation.

With the above orders, M.A. No. 1327 of 2015 stands disposed of.
