	Item No. 23 March 23, 2015	<p>We direct that the Applicant unit should operate to its optimum capacity forthwith.</p> <p>The Regional Senior Most Officer of Punjab Pollution Control Board along with two other officers inspect the Applicant Industry at 11:00 AM on 25th March, 2015. There shall be a comprehensive inspection as already directed by the Tribunal. To clarify, it should be a comprehensive inspection report relating to treatment of the effluents, discharge of effluents, water source, whether there are meters fixed or not, whether the unit was operated to its optimum capacity or not, where the effluent is being discharged, collection and analysis of the samples prior to introduction into ETP, at the discharge point, if any by-pass arrangement exists at the site, and point of discharge into what ground water, drain etc. The quality of the water that is being used for irrigation purpose shall also be reported.</p> <p>It shall also be stated whether they are complying with the entire conditions of the consent order or not. The videography of the inspection shall be prepared.</p> <p>If the unit is found to be closed for whatever reasons and inspection is not permitted on 25th March, 2015 as</p>
