3. It will ensure that petrol pump – cum- service center do not operate without the consent of the DPCC in accordance with law. The Committee shall examine that preferably the service centers are not permitted to operate in the non conformity area except the ones which are already in existence as of September, 2014. Even these would be permitted to operate only when they obtain specific consent of the DPCC for running both the petrol pump and the service center. In future no petrol pump – cum- service center and/or service center simplicitor would be permitted to operate in non-conformity area. The Committee shall provide a specific methodology in consultation with the DPCC as to how the oil grease and lubricant taken out from the vehicles or engines is used, recycled and causes no pollution. This shall be done strictly in accordance with The Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008.

4. The Monitoring would also deal with the benzene in the ambient air surrounding the petrol pumps and it how should be checked.

5. Extraction and use of underground water will be monitored and meters shall be directed to be installed for which the service center would be required to pay to the respective Corporation in accordance with The Water (Prevention and Control Of Pollution) Cess Act, 1974 and The

Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974.

With the above directions this Application is finally disposed of while leaving the parties to bear their own costs.
