	<b>Date and Remarks</b>	<b>Orders of the Tribunal</b>
	<b>Item Nos. 8 &amp; 9 October 15, 2014</b>	<p>Vide our order dated 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2014, we had directed the Corporation, NCT, Delhi and the Pollution Control Board as well as the Police Authorities to file the Status Report in regard to the burning of plastic for compliance of the directions contained in the judgement of the Tribunal dated 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2013.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel appearing for the Corporation on 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 had prayed for further time to file the report. Two weeks further time was granted by the said order. The report was not filed. Again on 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2014, at the request of the Learned Counsel appearing for the Respondent, one week further time was granted to file the report.</p>

The matter has now been taken up today on 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2014. But till today, the report has not been filed. The Learned Counsel appearing for the North Municipal Corporation submits that the Corporation is taking effective steps to control the burning of plastic and to ensure the compliance of the order of the Tribunal dated 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2013.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant however disputes as a matter of fact and submits that complaint has been moved on 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 and thereafter on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 giving the facts and details of the burning of plastic in the area falling under this Corporation and still no action was taken.

In the circumstances afore indicated, we direct the Respondent's particularly, the NCT, Delhi, North Municipal Corporation, Delhi Pollution Control Committee and Police Authorities to inspect and submit the Status Report in regard to the above, positively within two weeks from today subject to payment of Rs.10,000/- as cost. The cost will be paid to the Applicant. This shall be shared by these three Departments.
