Item No. 1 11th November 2013	<p>Pursuant to our order dated 09.10.2013 and earlier order dated 04.09.2013, the respondents namely State of Madhya Pradesh, MP Pollution Control Board and the Municipal Commissioner, Gwalior have submitted their Action Taken Reports.</p> <p>We find that with a view to carry out the implementation of our directions, particularly with reference to complying with the directions of the Plastics Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011 issued on 04.02.2011 by the Ministry of Environment and Forest under its notification of the above date, steps have been taken by the respondents both with regard to creating awareness among the people as directed and for checking the manufacture, sale and distribution of plastic as well as polythene carry bags of impermissible standards.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel for the parties while pointing out from their respective reports submitted that complete information from all the concerned has not been received yet. We find that the directions which have been issued by the State Government and the initiatives which have been taken by the MP Pollution Control Board have been conveyed to all the concerned parties and District Administration of all the Districts and they require time for implementation. therefore, dispose of the matter.

We may add that with a view to see the compliance as well as the impact generated in compliance of the Plastics Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011 within the State of MP, all parties and more particularly the MP Pollution Control Board can submit their response for the aforesaid parties alone. In compliance, the MP Pollution Control Board shall file copies of their reports in the prescribed proforma in which they would indicate the details of what has been noticed by the Pollution Control Board in this behalf as required under rule 12 of the Rules, 2011.
