	The learned AGP Mr.Mulchandani, seeks time to file affidavit of the
	Forest Department. We take note of the fact that since long the Writ Petition
	was pending before the Hon'bleHigh Court and the Applicant is
2.1	unnecessarily being required to attend the High Court and this Tribunal,
	without much reason and rheum. The litigants who has ventilated such a
	public cause, should not be unnecessarily troubled to commute to the
	Tribunal again and again. However, considering significance of the issues
	mentioned above, we grant last chance to the Forest Department to file
	reply affidavit and in case, such affidavit is not filed, we put the Forest
	Department on notice that heavy cost of Rs.25,000/- or more will be put on
	it or that coercive action, may be taken for the purpose of filing of reply
	affidavit.

The learned AGP to inform the Director of National Board for Wildlife (NBWL), to give instructions as regards nature of permission granted for laying down of underground pipeline and the circumstances, particularly, pertaining to grant of such permission, in the context of present Application, before the next date.
