Let such reply be filed within three weeks. The Odisha O.A. Pollution Control Board is directed to serve the affidavit to the Id. counsel appearing for Respondent No. 6. Mr. Pani, Id. counsel appearing for the applicant is directed to submit the supplementary affidavit annexing the translated copy of the documents as annexed in vernacular language in the O.A. in English language and to serve the same upon the respective respondents by one week. Since the railway siding activities have already been stopped as submitted by the Odisha Pollution Control Board, another prayer for imposition of compensation amount for operating the siding for last so many years since 2005, as has been reported in the affidavit of Odisha PCB till the date of closer, will be considered on the next date of hearing. The Respondent No. 6 is directed to file an affidavit answering the point as to why this Tribunal will not impose huge amount of cost on compensation upon them for the purpose of restoration of the environment which so long was polluted by them. Such reply by Respondent No. 6 will be considered by us on the next date. Let an affidavit be also filed by Respondent No. 6 within three weeks fixing the responsibility upon the officer who is responsible for operating the railway siding without getting consent from the PCB.

It is the submission of Id. counsel appearing for Respondent Nos. 2 & 4 that reply has already been sent by speed post to the Registry of this Tribunal. However, it is reported by the Court Officer that as yet it has not been received by this Tribunal. Be that as it may, he is directed to file the same on the next date of hearing and copies of the same be served upon the respective respondents and the applicant. Having regard to the order of closure as already passed by State Pollution Control Board we are of the view that the unit will not operate till consent to operate is granted by the Odisha PCB.
