According to them stairs by the passage of time have broken and have become unduly slippery. In the coming festival of Chhath it is likely that people may gather on the river. Therefore, protection measures are required to be taken in respect of repairs of stairs and ghats.</p> <p>All the Learned Counsel appearing in this case including the applicant submits that they have no intention of expansion. No fresh construction and expansion of ghats is permitted.</p> <p>The Ghaziabad Development Authority would be</p>
