List this matter for hearing and directions on 14<sup>th</sup> February, 2014 on which date the Deputy Commissioner and the Superintendent of Police of Districts Faridabad and Gautam Budh Nagar shall remain present before the Tribunal and shall furnish complete details of the 23 dumpers which were involved in the illegal mining in these areas. They shall also inform the Tribunal as to the extent of
