Perused.</p> <p>Respondent No. 1 – Banka Municipality has placed before us two solutions to resolve the problem of drainage form the house of the applicant to the common drain vide synopsis dated 28.09.2015: (i) to clean drain pipe near existing drain pipe which brings the sewage from the property of the applicant across the road to the common drain in place presently and (ii) to have entirely new drainage system to be constructed across the road.</p> <p>A photograph annexed to the said synopsis at page-5 shows the bottom of the existing drain and the opening of the old pipeline across the drain from the property of the applicant. We grant liberty to the Municipality to open and clean the drain pipe which from this photograph appears to be at higher level than that of the bottom of the drain. Let this cleaning and opening of the drain be done. Applicant shall co-operate with the Municipality to open the drain pipeline leading to the drain. Report of the opening and cleaning of the drain pipe be made to us along with the photographs of the open drain. Let the report be placed before us on</p>

the next date of hearing.
