

products are taken to M/s Hump Fruit (P) Ltd. situate at Hapur for its disposal in accordance with law. It is revealed at Annexure O1 to the reply/objections that the M/s Hump Fruit (P) Ltd. is running rendering plant with the consent of the UPPCB dated 22.04.2014 valid till 31.12.2015.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Respondent No. 7, project proponent submits that they have made application to the UPPCB for installing rendering plant within the premises of the slaughter house and no sooner the permission is granted steps would be taken to install and commence such rendering plant and it would take 3 months for commissioning of such plant.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the CPCB submits that he has been instructed to make the statement on behalf of the UPPCB. According to him, the application for grant of consent to operate the Rendering Plant will be considered in accordance with law and will be disposed of within 4 weeks.

We do not see any further reason to indulge ourselves in the present application unless the applicant has something more to say. Presently none appears on behalf of the applicant. Keep this application for final disposal with a caveat that the application will be disposed of or dismissed if none appears on behalf of the applicant on the next date.

The applicant shall provide copies of the application along with the annexures thereto to the learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Respondents within 2 days, if not furnished.
