Pursuant to the directions of the Tribunal, the Tamil Nadu State Pollution Control Board (Board) on consideration of the application made by the Corporation of Chennai has granted NOC for the transportation of the trade effluent from Pulianthope slaughter house to STP at Kodungaiyur. A copy of the document is filed and perused. On perusal of the NOC issued by the Board to the Corporation of Chennai in respect of the slaughter house at Pulianthope it is noticed that four conditions are incorporated therein.</p> <p data-bbox="547 1279 1410 1682">Hence, it becomes necessary to issue a direction to the Board to monitor the compliance of those conditions by the authorities of Corporation of Chennai attached to the slaughter house at Pulianthope. If not complied with strictly, needless to say the Board has to initiate necessary strict actions thereon.</p> <p data-bbox="547 1720 1410 1977">The learned counsel for the applicant brought to the notice of the Tribunal that insofar as the Solid Waste Management concerned, no measures are made in respect of all the three slaughter houses and necessary direction</p>

In reply, the counsel for the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent, Corporation of Chennai seeks time for filing report in respect of all the three slaughter houses in the next hearing.
