Superintend/Station Master in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- to the satisfaction of the arresting Officer, in exercise of our powers and in terms of the provision of Section 19 (4) (a) of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010 read with Order XVI Rule 10(3) and Section 151 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, for their production before the Tribunal. The bailable warrant shall be executed by the SHO of the concerned area.

The Learned counsel appearing for NCT, Delhi submits that he has already filed affidavit in the registry of National Green Tribunal, however it is not in record. The Learned counsel appearing for NCT, Delhi shall ensure that it is placed on record.

All the Corporations, through their Commissioners, are directed to file affidavit. The Corporations which have not filed their affidavits should file the same stating as to how they propose to deal with the dumping sites under their jurisdiction and any proposed action for construction of waste to energy or any other plant to deal with the municipal solid waste in Delhi. NCT, Delhi and all the Corporations are directed to give the exact quantum of waste being generated in Delhi. The Notice in the connected matter has already been issued to NHAI, but they are not present.

Issue notice in the name of General Manager, NHAI. Registry will also inform him telephonically, to be present before the Tribunal on the next date of hearing.
