These appeals are filed challenging the order passed by the Appellate Authority – Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board in Appeal Nos.37 & 38 2016 and 39 & 40 of 2016 dismissing the appeals filed by the appellants herein, challenging the order of the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board rejecting their applications for Consent to operate the stone crushing units.
