	<b>Item No. 02 March 08, 2016</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>M.A. No. 197 of 2016</u></b></p> <p>We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties. The application is disposed of on the following terms:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The industry would be permitted to operate for a period of two weeks w.e.f. 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 and shall be shut its operation after expiry of two weeks.</li><li>2. Director, IIT, Kanpur shall nominate a appropriate Professor/Associate Professor to be the part of the inspection team within two days from today. He shall inform the name of the nominee to Member Secretary, U.P. Pollution Control Board as well as Central Pollution Control Board.</li><li>3. We would expect that all the three organisations fully cooperate and act in tandem to ensure proper</li></ol>

inspection, may be a surprise inspection.

We make it clear that any person who now defaults our order would be dealt with in accordance with law. This direction is necessitated for the reason that time was granted twice but the order of the Tribunal has not been complied with for the one reason or the other.

With the above directions M.A. No. 197 of 2016 stands disposed of without any order as to cost.

Report would be submitted to the Tribunal and inspection should be conducted preferably within 10 days from today.
